



Dear Homeowners:

The Tulsa International Airport's Noise Mitigation Program is coming to an end. Roughly 1550 homes have been treated since the program started in 2000. You are receiving this letter because you are not currently signed up for the Program. Although you may have been contacted in the past to participate in the Program, it is our desire to offer you a final opportunity to participate in the Program.

The Noise Mitigation Program is a voluntary program for owners of property lying within the defined noise exposure zones near the airport. The program offers the homeowner the following three choices:

- **Noise Mitigation:** This has become a popular option nationally. Homes can be modified to significantly reduce interior aircraft noise based upon a plan unique to each participating residence. This may include replacing windows and doors, insulating attics, and if necessary installation of a central air ventilation system.
- **Sales Assistance:** For those who wish to sell their homes and move to another location, the NMP will guarantee, up to pre-established limits, the difference between actual sale price of the home and its pre-determined fair market value. Homeowners interested in the Sales Assistance option should contact the QuieterHome® office as soon as possible to schedule a meeting to discuss the timing of this option.
- **Easement Acquisition:** A single payment in exchange for the easement based upon a community wide land value analysis. (\$2,500.00)
